Re: Class I Gaming License Application

In accordance with the Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe's Gaming Code section **3.5 Classes of Gaming:**

3.5.1 "Class I Gaming" means social gaming solely for prizes of minimal value or traditional forms of Indian gaming engaged by individuals as part of or in connection with tribal ceremonies or celebration.

Approval from the Gaming Commission **MUST** be obtained prior to selling of raffle tickets or drawings of any kind.

If you are having multiple drawings or raffles, <u>each one **MUST** have a separate Class I License</u> Application.

To be considered complete, the Class I Gaming License Application MUST include a full disclosure of all prizes along with the fair market value of each prize.

All persons whose Class I's events that overlap or occur during a gathering, convention or community events such as; SCIT Pow Wow, Community Meetings, SCIT Developmental Events, etc. Must FIRST obtain permission from the respected event coordinator before the Gaming Commission will approve a Class I Gaming License. This written approval must be indicated by the signature on the bottom of the application or Gaming Commission will not approve your Class I until such approval has been submitted to the Commission.

Please note that Class I Gaming Licenses are <u>only valid within the boundaries of the Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe's reservation.</u> If your event does not occur within the reservation boundaries then you must obtain a license from the State of Michigan to hold your raffle. Any tax paperwork required by IRS Standards is the responsibility of the person or committee applying for the license.
