Services

The Victim Advocate Office of the Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe treats each crime victim as a unique individual and attempts to provide services in the best possible way for that person. The victim advocates will act as a liaison between the victim and other criminal justice agencies such as the police, tribal court and the probation department. The victim advocates will provide information and assistance with restitution and provide information and referrals for community services.

Resources for Crime Victims

The Crime Victim Compensation program helps people who are physically, mentally, or emotionally harmed because of a crime. There is a 5-year deadline to apply. For more information call the Victims-Only Toll-Free Helpline at 877-251-7373.

The Crime Victims Legal Assistance Project (CVLAP) is a statewide program with lawyers across Michigan. CVLAP provides free legal help to clients who have experienced domestic violence and to clients who are at least 55 years old and have experienced abuse, neglect, or exploitation.
